

Mathematics

In maths we will be learning to:

Money

- recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes
- solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction

Multiplication and division

- recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of a quantity
- solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher
- recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of a quantity

Measures: Capacity and Volume

- compare, describe and solve practical problems for: lengths and heights, mass/weight, capacity and volume
- measure and begin to record the following: lengths and heights; mass/weight; capacity and volume

Science -

- Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.
- Grow our own beanstalk, recording the growth overtime in our own 'bean diaries'

R.E – Christianity

In RE we will be learning about:

- The creation story
- The instruction we were given to care for God's creation
- How we are all made in different ways and we are special and unique
- Why we care for the world and the people in it

Literacy

In literacy we are learning to:

Traditional and Fairy Tales

- Identify the structure of a traditional and fairy story.
- To learn and retell the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.
- To read a variety of versions of Jack and the Beanstalk, using our own opinions to decide which we prefer and why
- Use the language and structure of Jack and the Bean stalk to create our own versions of the story.

Punctuation and Grammar

- Write descriptively by including adjectives in our writing.
- To think about the use of the word 'and'
- To continue to work on our capital letters, full stops and finger spaces
- Understand compound words


