

English - Writing in Year 3



Fiction The children will be describing settings, characters and plot using the text "The BFG" by Roald Dahl. They will also learn the features of a diary and write an entry as Sophie.

Grammar - This half term the children will be focusing on how to use direct speech in writing and how adverbs indicate time, place or manner.

E.g. Silently, the mouse crept along the path
Yesterday, I visited my grandparents in Brighton.
Upstairs, I could hear noises.

Non Fiction, The children will research, plan and write an information text about volcanoes in South America using headings and subheadings.

Science - **Brilliant Biology!** The children will learn about the body and identify that animals, including humans need the right types of nutrition and that they cannot make their own food. They will also learn that humans and other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

R.E In R.E the children will be learning about Hinduism and what it means to be a **Hindu**.

Autumn Term 1 Curriculum Map

English - Reading in Year 3

1. The children will be learning how to change their own reading books & will be given a book change day. This will be written in your child's reading record.
2. This half term the children will also be adjusting to key stage 2 reading with whole class or partner reading sessions. They will build upon reading with expression and intonation for different punctuation elements and develop their comprehension skills by learning how to infer or predict characters' feelings.

Geography Focus - The children will be learning about the geographical similarities and differences of South America and The United Kingdom.

BIG QUESTION

Where are most of South America's Volcanoes?

P.E - **Time to swim!** The children will learn how to swim competently and proficiently over a distance, this will enhance their confidence and agility in water. The children will also be learning basic street dance skills and lead their own warm ups developing co-ordination rhythm and team building skills.

Art- The children will be creating artwork based on South America and Volcanoes. We shall also be looking at famous artists from South America.

Maths in Year 3

Number Strategies

- Say the value of each digit in a 2-digit number.
- **Compare and order numbers within 100.** - Explain how a known fact can be used to derive new facts from a known fact. E.g. if $45 + 5 = 50$ therefore $50 - 5 = 45$
- **Investigate number bonds up to 20.**
- Apply number bonds up to 20 to calculate with regrouping.
- **Round and adjust to add and subtract with near-multiples of ten.**
- Round and adjust to add with near dou
- **Calculate the difference.**
- Solve money problems using mental calculating strategies.



Place Value

- Identify the value of each digit in a 3-digit number.
- **Partition 3-digit numbers in different ways.**
- Order and compare 3-digit number.
- **Find 10 and 100 more or less than a given number.**
- Round 3-digit numbers to the nearest multiple of ten.
- **Apply place value knowledge to problem-solving.**

Graphs

- Read, interpret & create pictograms, bar graphs and tally charts with different scales.
