

1. Addition & Subtraction

Mentally add / subtract a single digit number to / from a 3-digit number, including regrouping

Mentally add/subtract a multiple of ten

from a 3-digit number, including regrouping

Mentally add / subtract a multiple of 100 to / from a 3-digit number (within 1000)

Use rounding to estimate the answer to a calculation

Solve 1 and 2 step addition and subtraction word problems

Add 3-digit numbers using column addition

Subtract 3-digit numbers using column subtraction

2. Length and Perimeter.

Measure lengths to the nearest centimetre or to the nearest millimetre

Measure and draw lines of a given length in mixed units (cm and mm)

Use prior knowledge to estimate length

Understand and calculate the perimeters of 2-D shapes in centimetres & millimetres

Measure and compare lengths in mixed units (m and cm)

Calculate perimeters of 2-D shapes in metres and centimetres.

French

We shall begin our French in Year 3 this half term by practicing basic greetings and counting skills.

"Step into the Stone Age"



Curriculum drivers **History & Art**

The children will explore farming, houses and culture from the Stone Age to the Iron Age .

Year 3 shall be visiting Butser Ancient Farm/Stone Age village in Hampshire on Friday 30th November .

Here the children will experience life during the Stone Age! In Art & D&T the children will be designing, making and evaluating their own Stone Age jewellery and create cave paintings inspired by Stone Age art and learn why they were important.

Science ROCKS!

The children will be learning all about rocks! By comparing and grouping together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. They will learn in simple terms how fossils are formed and recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.



Religious Education

Physical Education

In P.E, the children will be continue their swimming this half term. The last swimming lesson will be Tuesday 4th December. The children will also be continuing their house dance and learning to perform their routines in groups and compare them with previous routines.

English



Writing- Fiction

In English we will be using the story "**Stone Age Boy**" by **Satoshi Kitamura**. The children will use this text to write their own Stone Age themed story. They will learn how to write interesting sentences using adjectives and nouns and extend their sentences by using a range of **conjunctions** learning the difference between a **subordinating and co-ordinating conjunction**. They will also be learning how to use **direct speech** within story writing and focus closely on how to spell **Year 3 common exception words** .

Writing – Non-Fiction

The children will be writing a set of instructions about how they made their Stone Age Jewellery using **imperative (bossy) verbs and time adverbs**. The children will be **learning** what instructions are and why they are important.

Reading

The children will learn what a paragraph is and how to identify a paragraph in text. The children will be reading aloud with expression and building upon their comprehension skills by learning how to quote the text within their written answers. The children will be using their predicting skills to write what happens next in a story.

Music

In music shall be looking at Rhythm and tempo by creating our own music pieces using a glockenspiel.

PSHE

This years anti bullying week theme is "choose respect" so in Year 3 we are going to focus on what respect is and the importance of having respect for each other, ourselves and our belongings .
