

Maths – Perimeter and Area, Measure and Money, Shape and Symmetry

We are learning to:

- Measure and calculate the perimeter of a rectilinear figure (including squares) in centimetres and metres
- Find the area of rectilinear shapes by counting squares.
- Convert between different units of measure [for example, kilometre to metre; hour to minute].
- Estimate, compare and calculate different measures, including money in pounds and pence.
- Identify lines of symmetry in 2-D shapes presented in different orientations.
- Complete a simple symmetric figure.

Science – Teeth and Digestion

We are learning to:

- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.

R.E – The Bible

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We are learning to:

- Understand the 'big ideas' from the bible and relate this to Christian life.

French – Body

We are learning to:

- Identify parts of the body and give basic character descriptions.

P.E – Orienteering/Athletics

We are learning to:

- Take part in outdoor and adventurous activity challenges both individually and within a team (orienteering).
- Use running, jumping, throwing and catching in athletics.

We are learning to:

Writing

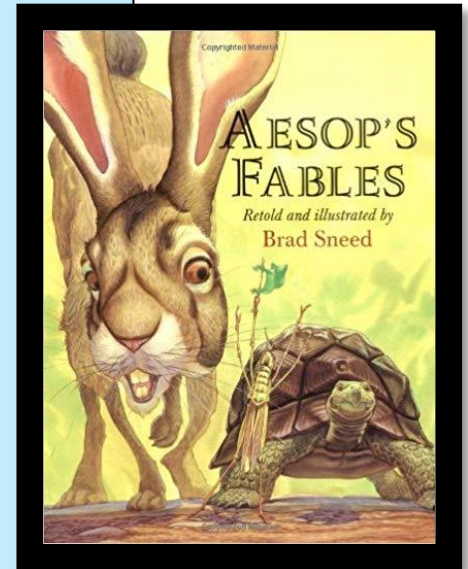
- Learn a fable off my heart using story mapping.

- Draw inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justifying inferences with evidence.
