## How the money raised is used:

Every year the PTFA commits to over **£4,000** of regular funding. Going forwards this will be things like new books for classrooms; funding the Year 6 leavers' party; subsidising the transport for school trips and visits; theatre groups at School; contributions towards residential trips; providing funds to teachers for them to choose classroom resources; ice lollies at Sports Day; the Christmas Tree in December and so on.

In addition to our regular funding, this year, we have also committed to funding **£6,000 towards** the revamped playground, forest school areas, sandpit and sensory gardens to encourage and enable outdoor learning.




#### **Upcoming Events:**
