

# St Mary's Hampton outcomes and targets, 2023-24

The table below shows the outcomes from statutory assessments in 2023. The 2022 results and the national averages are included for comparison, alongside this year's predicted outcomes based on current assessments. It is important to remember that the smaller the cohort, the less statistically relevant the national data is. Phonics and Maths have become school improvement priorities this year. Last year's Year 1 cohort had a lower baseline, which impacted phonics outcomes and end of KS1 2024 predicted outcomes. In Key Stage 2 in 2023, 85% of children were projected to meet the threshold for expected Maths. However, question level analysis of the test papers revealed that 5 children missed the pass mark by one or two marks.
